

Things You Need to Know About This Event and How to Register

- While this program was designed with the educational needs of homeschoolers in mind, any family with school age children is invited to attend.
- This event is for students ages 6 – 18, and for adults whose children are in other workshops. Each workshop has a listed age range; only students in that age range may participate – no exceptions. We apologize, but we are unable to accommodate children under 6 during this program. Please see our website for information on our preschool program offerings.
- One parent must be on the farm for the duration of the event.
- To enhance the experience, participants are encouraged to come in period dress, but it is not mandatory.
- Lunches are available to order from Subway, or you may bring your own. Lunches must be ordered by April 2. **No refunds will be given or changes allowed after that date.**
- Registration will begin at 9 a.m. on February 1. Registrations will be taken by phone or in person, and you may see on-line how many spaces are still available for all workshops. Quiet Valley's phone numbers are 570-992-6161 or 570-402-0562. The prices for the workshops will be listed on the website, and some workshops will have an extra materials fee. Please be patient if you are unable to get through immediately. We usually experience heavy call volume, especially during the first hour, so just keep trying. Registration for all workshops will close as of April 2, 2018.
- There will be a scavenger hunt on Friday afternoon, from 2:30 – 4:00 for the entire family. The price for this is \$5.00 for each student, free for parents.
- Registration is complete only when payment is received. Payment by credit card or check is recommended. No workshop changes will be permitted once payment is received. **No refunds will be given after March 20.**
- There are a limited number of spots available in the workshops, so make your reservation early.
- While Quiet Valley is not a typical museum, our buildings are very old and we do have antique furniture and tools in all of the buildings. Please follow all instructions given to you by the staff as to which items may be used or touched and do not enter any building without a staff person being present. Flash photography and recording in the rooms is not permitted. Also, please be respectful of our animals and follow all instructions from the farmer on how to behave around them.
