One Room Schoolhouse Student/Parent Information

We here at Quiet Valley Living Historical Farm look forward to your participation in the One Room School Program. In order to make your experience as authentic, educational and enriching as possible, we ask that you follow a few procedural details. Please be aware of the following items and adhere to them as closely as possible.

- Remember that the experience will be a reenactment, as lifelike as possible, of a typical school day in 1893. Students will experience, and are expected to follow, the customs, school procedures and daily routine of an 1893 school house. Students should be prepared to interact within this framework.
- Please be aware that the One Room School is a short walk from the main farm area and that students should be prepared to walk briefly outdoors. Please dress appropriately.
- Bathrooms, like those in 1893, are located outdoors and separate from the school itself. Hand sanitizer is provided for student use.
- Students should, if at all possible, attempt to dress themselves in period clothing as much as possible.
- Please be aware of the season and bring caps, gloves, etc. as appropriate. Proper shoes are a must owing to the outdoor nature of the environment; boots should be considered. Please avoid wearing modern sneakers.
- All students are expected to adhere to the guidelines above.
