

QUIET VALLEY JUNIOR VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

Pre-teens and teens ages 10 to 17 work alongside Museum staff throughout the summer, sharing tours and programs with visitors. This is a great opportunity to serve your community while making friends who also love the Museum!

- All Junior Volunteers are trained and supervised. However, all Junior Volunteers must be able to work independently because supervisors cannot be present at all times.
- Junior Volunteers are expected to learn tour content for their assigned area and assist in presenting tours during their volunteer shifts.
- Participants are also expected to wear historically appropriate dress. Quiet Valley has a limited number of costume pieces available for rental.
- A variety of locations are available, including
 - Barn (1850; farming and animal husbandry)
 - Cellar Kitchen/Bedroom (1820; open hearth cooking)
 - Parlor/New Kitchen (1893; Victorian era; summer volunteering is the only time students can work in this area)
 - Cabin (1820; spinning/weaving)
- Participants will also complete a historically appropriate craft or project during the course of their volunteer time.
- Junior Volunteers are expected to commit a total of 25 hours throughout the course of the summer. We understand that summers can be busy times. Volunteer schedules will be created based on family availability.
 - Volunteer shifts will be scheduled to take place on Monday-Saturday in either mornings (10am-1pm) or afternoons (1pm-4pm)
- Students will be allowed to reschedule a maximum of three shifts due to family vacations, illness, or other commitments.
- Participants must be Quiet Valley members (either a student or family membership)
- All participants who complete the required 25 hours will be rewarded with a camp out celebration held at Quiet Valley. This year's camp out will take place on Thursday, August 13, 2021.

Important Dates

- The program will run for the duration of our summer season, from June 22 through August 14, 2021.
- Participants will need to attend two training sessions on Mondays, June 7 and 14, 2021 from 10am-1:30pm.
